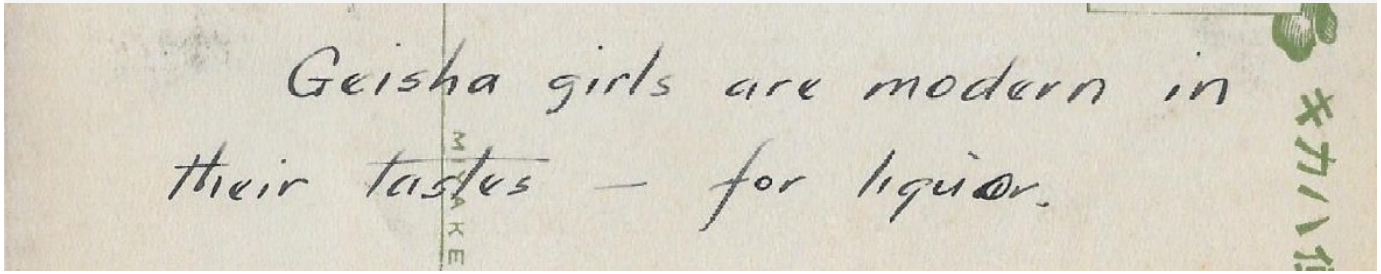

From the Archive

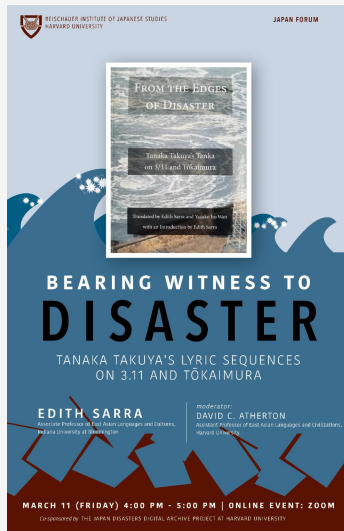


Every newsletter, the Japan Society of Boston will pull an image from our archive. This postcard was sent back to Boston from Japan in the year 1914

and depicts a group of Geisha sitting around drinking. The Back Simply reads, "Geisha Girls are modern in their tastes -- for Liquor."



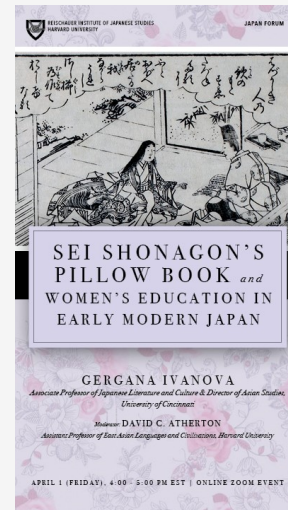

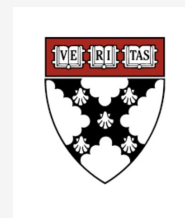
