Facts about Hokkaido in honor of the Massachusetts Hokkaido Sister State Relationship

Did you know that this year marks the 30th Anniversary of the Massachusetts Hokkaido Sister State Relationship?

There are two cities in Hokkaido, that have sister-city relationships with cities in Massachusetts. Springfield and Takikawa City became sister cities in 1993 and in 1997, after a five year courtship, the Concord Town Meeting voted to formalize the sister city relationship with Nanae Town in Hokkaido.

OOO (OOOO): "Hinamatsuri"

Doll Festival

On March 3rd, the Japanese observe \(\subseteq \subsete \) (hinamatsuri or the Doll Festival). Families display intricately crafted dolls dressed in the traditional court attire of the Heian period (794 – 1185) to celebrate their young daughters' happiness and health. The dolls are displayed only once a year and are quickly put away the day after hinamatsuri because superstition dictates that leaving the dolls out too long will delay a daughter's marriage. Hinamatsuri is also called \(\subseteq \subseteq \subsete \) (momo no sekku, the Peach Flower Festival), and many Japanese women have fond memories of spring, setting up the dolls carefully with their families, then taking them down when the peach flowers bloom.
